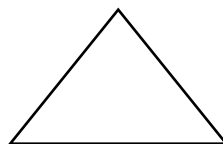

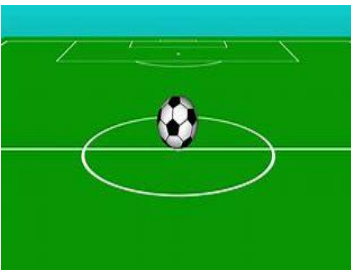

One of the oldest system of writing was cuneiform. It was developed by early humans living in Mesopotamia. This writing system included symbols or pictures drawn with the help of a pointed tool on soft clay tablets. This tool was made from reed. The letters were mainly drawn in the shape of a wedge. The script from which these letters were derived was called cuneiform script. Some neighbours of Mesopotamians also used cuneiform including Persians and hithites. People used this writing system to note down information regarding business, trade and temple activities. They also wrote myths, stories and letters using this system.
